It is with great respect and admiration that I extend my heartfelt congratulations to the Coconut Growers Association of Sri Lanka on the occasion of its 31st Annual General Meeting, being held under the theme “Protect ‘Ceylon Coconut’ before it’s too late.” This theme is both powerful and timely, calling attention to a critical challenge facing the coconut sector in Sri Lanka and across many producing countries.

The CGASL, as one of the observer organizations of the International Coconut Community (ICC), has consistently demonstrated its commitment to advocating for the welfare of coconut growers and the advancement of Sri Lanka’s coconut industry. The role played by CGASL in uniting growers, voicing their concerns, and championing productivity-focused initiatives is commendable and well aligned with the shared vision of the ICC.

At ICC, our mission is to “Promote, Coordinate and Harmonize the activities of the coconut industry to achieve a sustainable, resilient, inclusive and highly profitable coconut sector globally.” This includes improving farmer productivity and income, enhancing market access, supporting climate resilience, and strengthening multi-stakeholder collaboration across member countries. We view CGASL’s ongoing work as an important contribution toward these objectives.

The urgency behind this year’s AGM theme is fully understood and acknowledged. Despite an increase in global demand for coconut-based products, driven by rising interest in health-conscious, plant-based, and sustainable ingredients, Sri Lanka’s coconut sector is grappling with declining yields and production challenges. The years 2024 and 2025 have particularly revealed structural weaknesses, including aging palms, insufficient replanting, erratic weather patterns, pest and disease pressures, and land-use constraints. These challenges must be met head-on to safeguard the legacy and future of the “Ceylon Coconut”, a name that carries both historical and market value on the international stage.

In the broader trade context, the international coconut market remains vibrant, with steady demand in both traditional segments [such as copra, desiccated coconut, and coconut oil] and emerging categories [like coconut water, virgin coconut oil, activated carbon, and coconut-based bioproducts]. However, for growers to benefit from these opportunities, supply-side strengthening is imperative. Without a focused push to improve on-farm productivity, promote high-yielding varieties, integrate climate-smart practices, and expand research-extension linkages, Sri

Lanka risks losing competitiveness in global markets where new players continue to emerge.

The solution lies in collective effort. Growers, processors, research institutions, and policy stakeholders must collaborate more than ever. Organizations such as CGASL serve as a vital bridge between growers and national as well as international partners. The ICC will continue to support its member countries by providing strategic policy guidance, facilitating knowledge exchange and capacity-building, promoting market development and trade, supporting productivity improvement and sustainability, strengthening standards and quality assurance, and mobilizing resources through effective partnerships, ensuring that no producing country is left behind in the global coconut economy.

We are particularly encouraged by CGASL’s advocacy for farmer-centric reforms and its role in promoting dialogue on productivity, branding, and value addition. The emphasis on protecting “Ceylon Coconut” is not just a marketing strategy, it is a call to preserve a national heritage while unlocking new economic value for rural communities.

As the Director General of ICC, I assure you of our unwavering support in your efforts to overcome current challenges and to uplift the livelihoods of coconut- growing communities in Sri Lanka. ## Message from President Coconut Grower's Association of Sri Lanka

I would like to extend my greetings to the members on the occasion of the 31st Annual General Meeting and Technical Session of CGASL. This annual event serves as a valuable platform for sharing information on the management of coconut plantations, addressing current challenges, and exploring new opportunities. Additionally, it provides members with the opportunity to network, exchange knowledge, renew old acquaintances, and establish new connections.

The association now operates a secretariat for its members at the National Chamber of Commerce of Sri Lanka (NCCSL) in Colombo, managed by an Executive Officer. This allows the Board of Directors and sub-committees to function independently for the benefit of the association.

CGASL can now communicate with its members through WhatsApp, SMS, Facebook, LinkedIn, Website, and E-bulletin, offering valuable information on GAP and market data to ensure a reasonable farmgate price for their produce. We have also connected growers with input suppliers and facilitated virtual meetings with the branch network and other stakeholders such as CCB and CRI, utilizing the resources available at the secretariat.

Coconut production in Sri Lanka fell from 2.95 billion nuts in 2023 to 2.7 billion in 2024, with some growers encountering a 30% reduction in yield. Despite a rise in the average farm gate price from Rs 65/- to Rs 110/- during the year, growers experienced minimal financial benefits due to reduced yield and increased costs.

Growers face challenges such as labor shortages, pest and disease management, and climate change. Innovations in agricultural methods and technology offer solutions to boost productivity and improve market access. However, sustainability remains a concern, as reliance on coconut as a single crop prompts the need for investment in subsidiary crops.

Given that seventy percent of coconut production is derived from home gardens, it is crucial to disseminate sustainable methods of crop protection and yield enhancement to growers while maintaining a viable farmgate price to incentivize them. CGASL has undertaken an initiative to engage home growers in partnership with SARVODAYA through a pilot project in Marawila.

Your association collaborated with other coconut stakeholder associations to form the Ceylon Chamber of Coconut Industry (CCCI) to enhance industry cooperation, improve supply chains, and address threats collectively. The initiative was sponsored by the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO).

The CGASL partnership within CCCI has encountered challenges due to low yields and requests from exporters and manufacturers for short-term imports of manufactured coconut products to meet export orders and permit the import of coconuts.

CGASL notified the government that importing coconut products could impact the farmgate price and the brand value of "Ceylon Coconut". Furthermore, the import of coconuts would not comply with existing statutes and poses a risk to plantations due to potential pest and disease issues.

Currently CGASL via CCCI is engaged with the Ministry of Plantation Industries & Community Infrastructure, CDA, CRI, CCB in developing a Strategic Plan and a Road Map for the coconut industry, with the participation of the Institute of Policy Studies of Sri Lanka (IPS) and sponsored by UNIDO.

At the request of CGASL, UNIDO is sponsoring a Geographic Information System (GIS) pilot project in the Kuliypitiya East area. The objective of this initiative is to evaluate the coconut palm count, palm health, and other pertinent parameters to support the Strategic Plan and Road Map. CGASL underscores the necessity of establishing a national policy for the coconut industry. Given that coconut is a perennial crop, it is crucial for all stakeholders to harmonize their efforts to enhance productivity.

I express my gratitude to the Chief Guest, Mr. B. K. Prabath Chandrakeerthi, Secretary of the Ministry of Plantation Industries and Community Infrastructure; as well as the distinguished guest speakers, Professor Jagath Chaminda Edirisinghe, Dean of the Faculty of Agriculture at Wayamba University, and Professor Ajith Jayaweera, Chairman of CRI, for their presence at this event.

To the members of the association, your participation at the event is appreciated. Your active involvement in all discussions strengthens the association's ability to advocate for member issues. Additionally, your financial contributions are crucial for maintaining the services provided.

CGASL extends its sincere appreciation to the sponsors for their continued generosity in supporting this event. We are confident that our members now have a clearer understanding of the products and services available.

The co-directors of the board worked diligently to ensure this year was dynamic, and I am grateful to everyone for their significant contributions, which have shaped the organization into a respected voice that is frequently consulted.



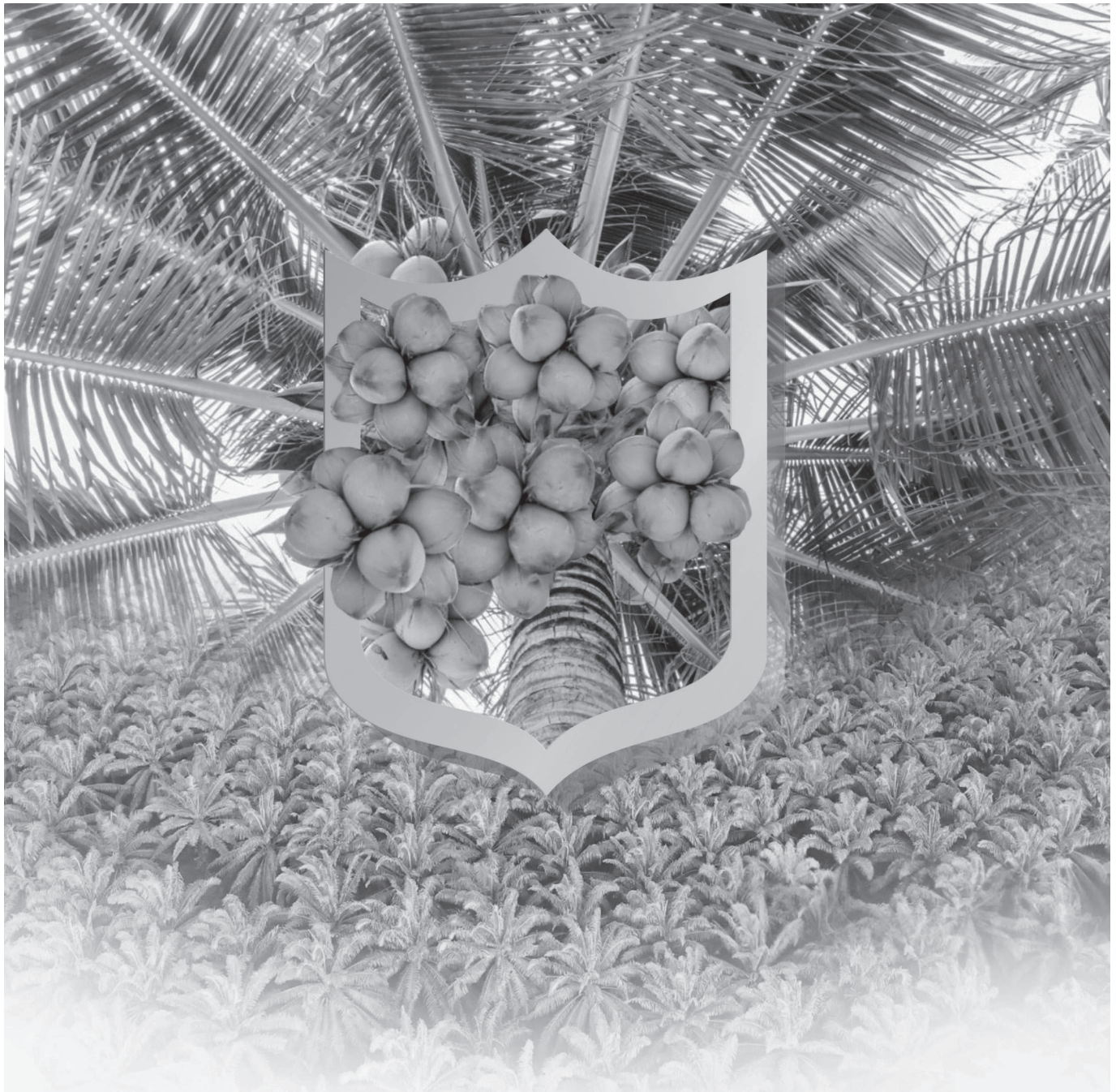
